2024 in the Northern Luberon is a fairly typical year... though marked by some recent features of the current climate: humid, quite mild, and contrasted. Winter was rather cold and sometimes dry, while spring and autumn were fairly rainy.

Fortunately, these periods quickly alternated with fine weather and a bit of wind to keep conditions healthy. The summer was pleasantly warm, without excess heat or significant water stress. Overall, a classic Luberon year: rapid alternation between sunshine and disturbances, with characteristically pleasant Provençal temperatures.

Blend: 66% Grenache and 33% Syrah

This cuvée comes from a blend of three parcels:

The largest is a magnificent one-hectare *clos* surrounded by woodland. The limestone bedrock is covered by more than 50 cm of clay, *safre* (sandy marl),

and ochre. The vines—old Grenache planted in 1969—are among the latest-ripening in the Vaucluse.

The second parcel, another small *clos*, differs with a more chalky and sandy soil. The vines are the same age but were harvested a few days earlier. Finally, the Syrah from *Le Devens* plays a prominent role in this relatively light-textured vintage. The profile is floral, airy, and silky.

In vinification, stainless steel tightens the palate and gives this vintage its lifted structure. The balance is precise, with gentle, infusion-style extraction.
